Cleaning Products: laundry detergent and pods, dish washing soap and pods, antibacterial wipes, spray cleaners, Lysol

<u>Personal Hygiene Products</u>: shampoo and conditioner, <u>unscented</u> soaps, deodorants, Kleenex, shaving supplies

They could also use some **specific food items**: cooking oils, salad dressings, mayo, coffee & tea (both caffeinated and decaffeinated).
